Rock Around the Clock 50's Dance Party

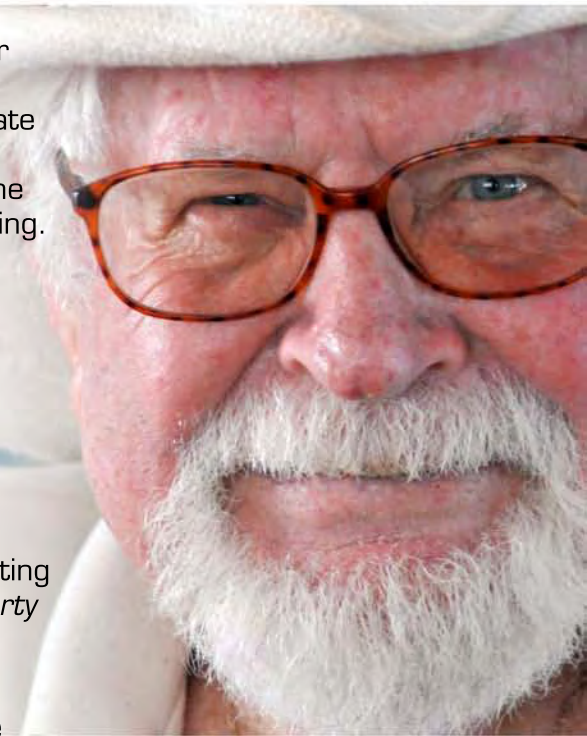

EPISODES IN DEVELOPMENT:
